Notes

Flood Warning Areas are areas where flooding is expected to occur and where a Flood Warning Service is provided. They define locations within the Flood Warning Service Limit that represent a discrete community at risk of flooding; containing properties that are expected to flood from rivers or the sea and in some areas, from groundwater. Flood Warnings are issued when flooding is expected to occur, to alert people that flooding is expected and that they are encouraged to take action to protect themselves and their property. Some areas may be covered by more than one flood warning area as they may be at risk of flooding from more than one watercourse.

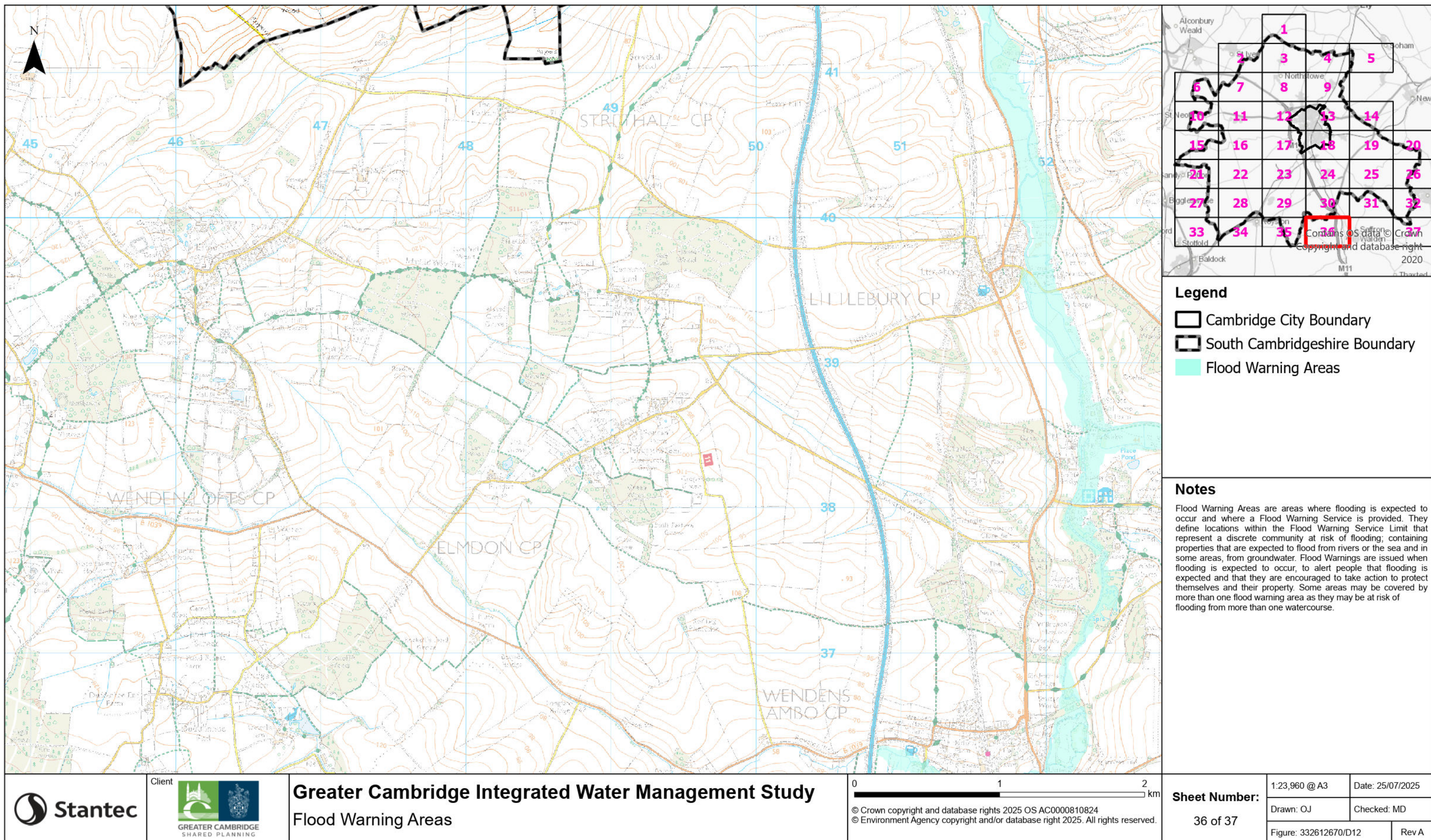


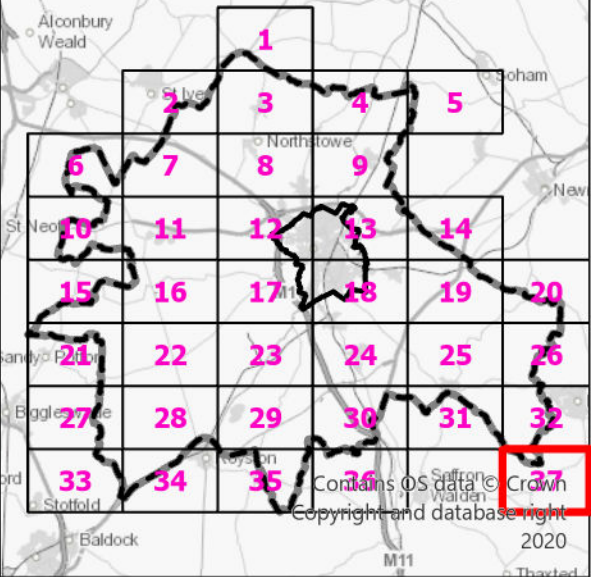
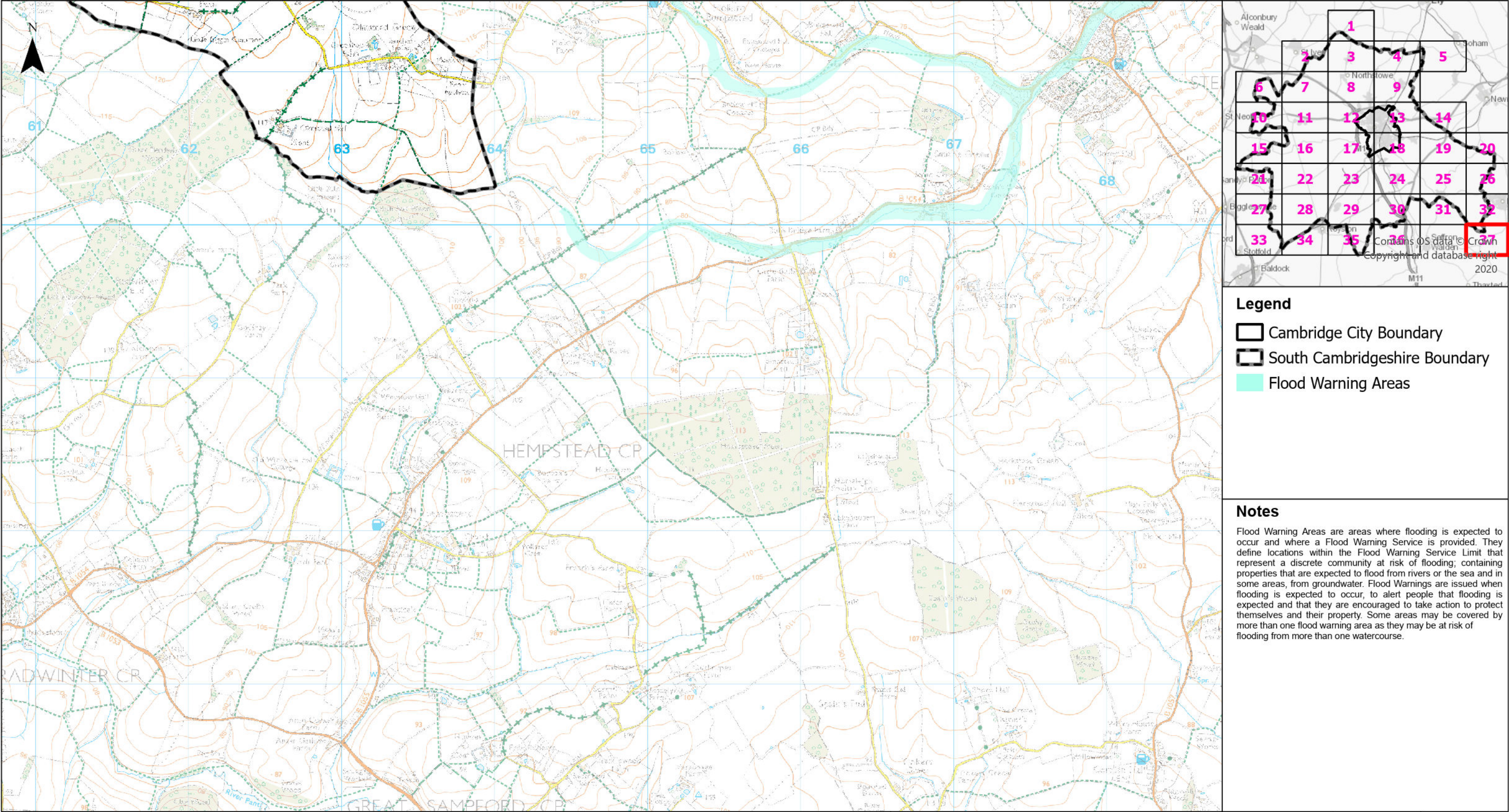
