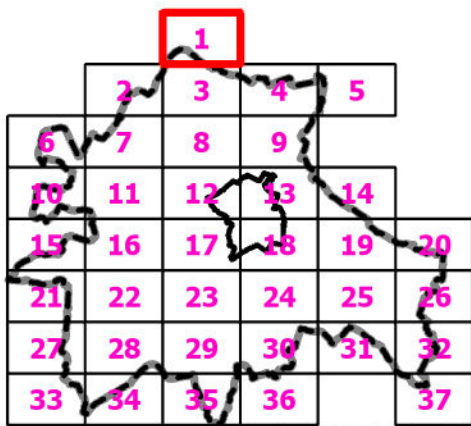
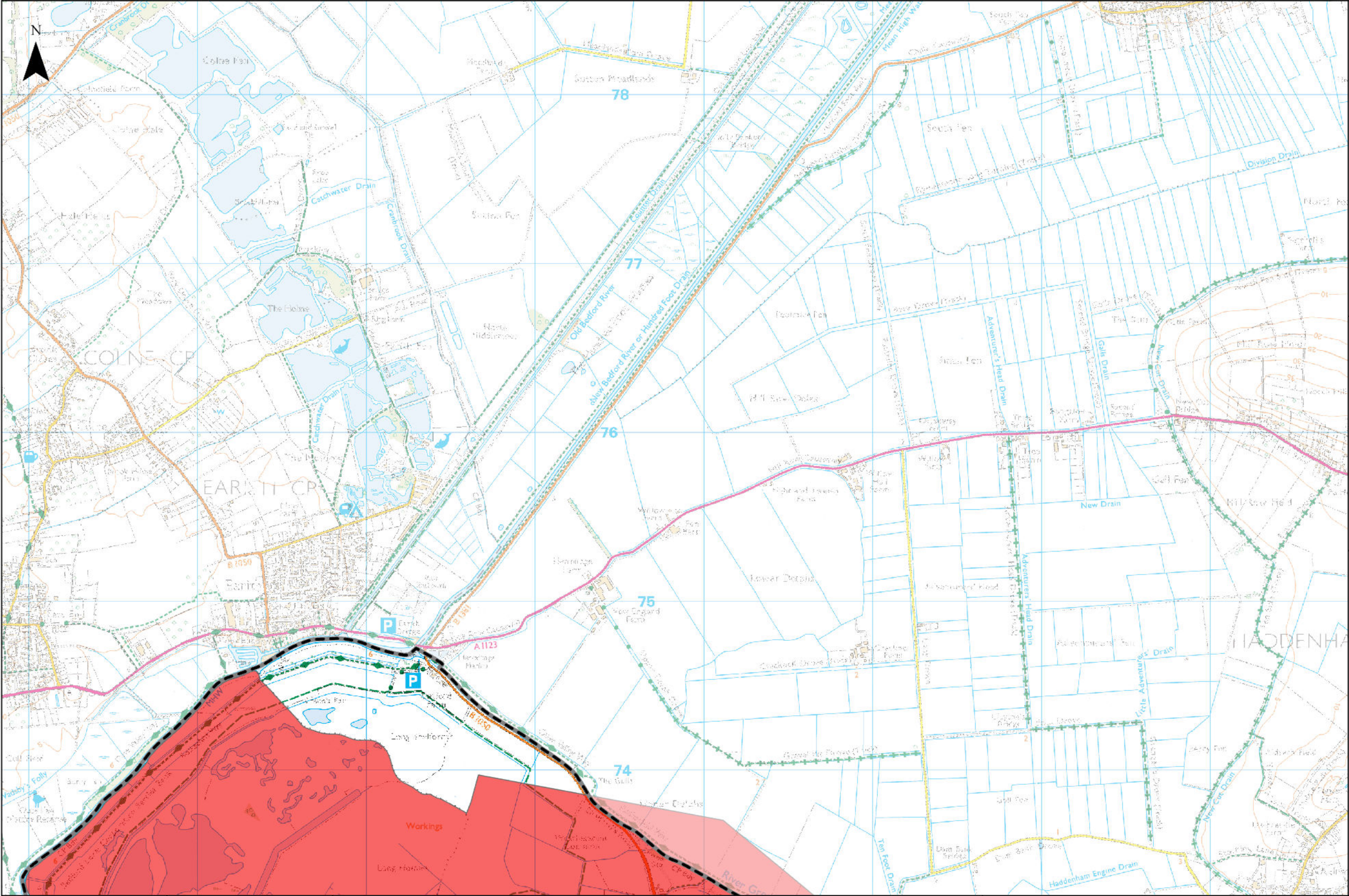

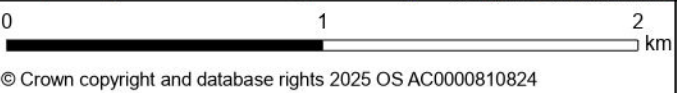

The Historic Sewer Flooding map uses the DG5 register provided by the sewerage company, Anglian Water, which is a record of all reported sewer flooding incidents.

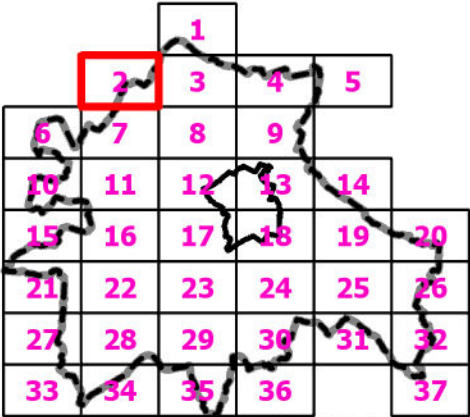
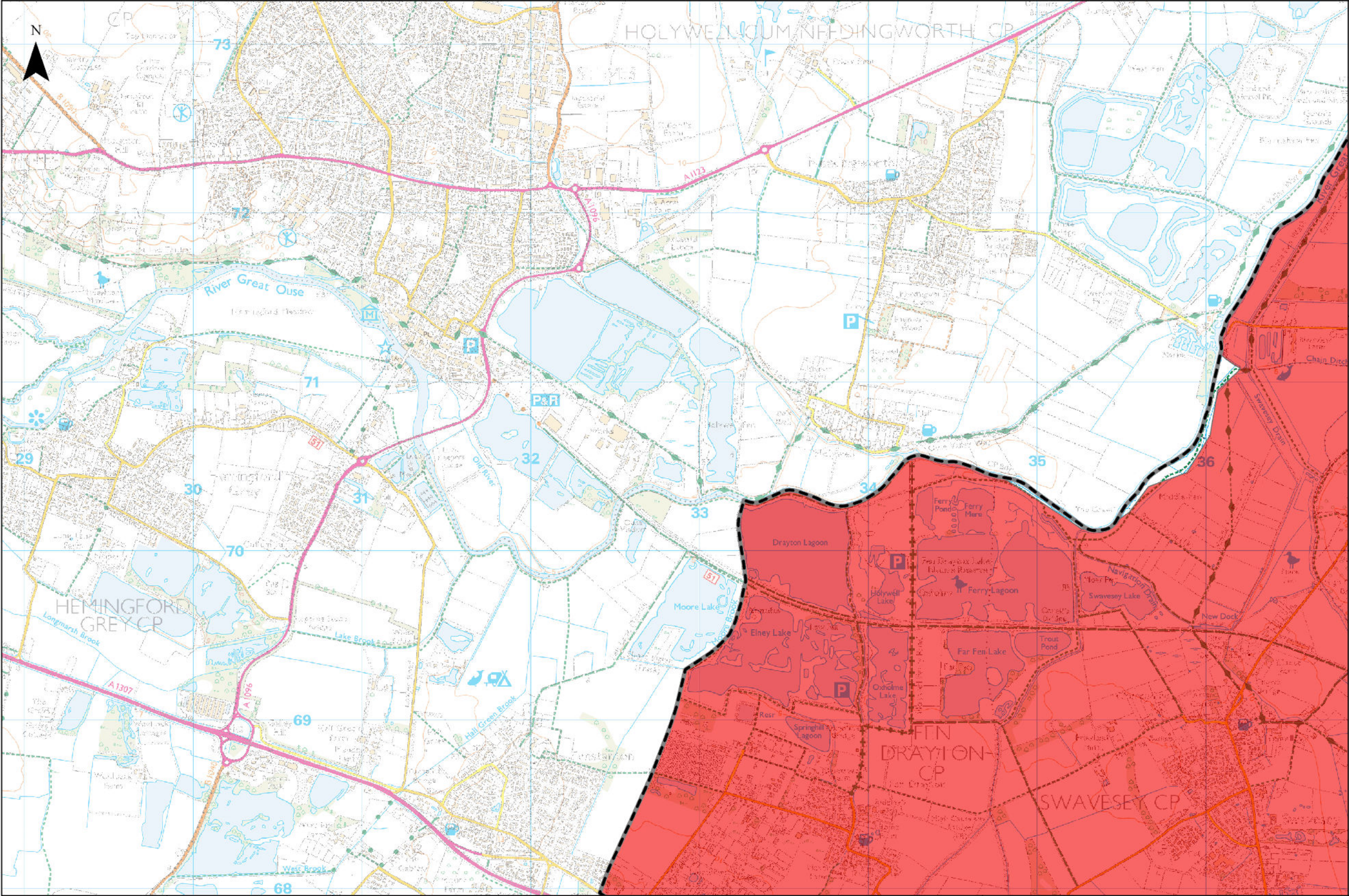
