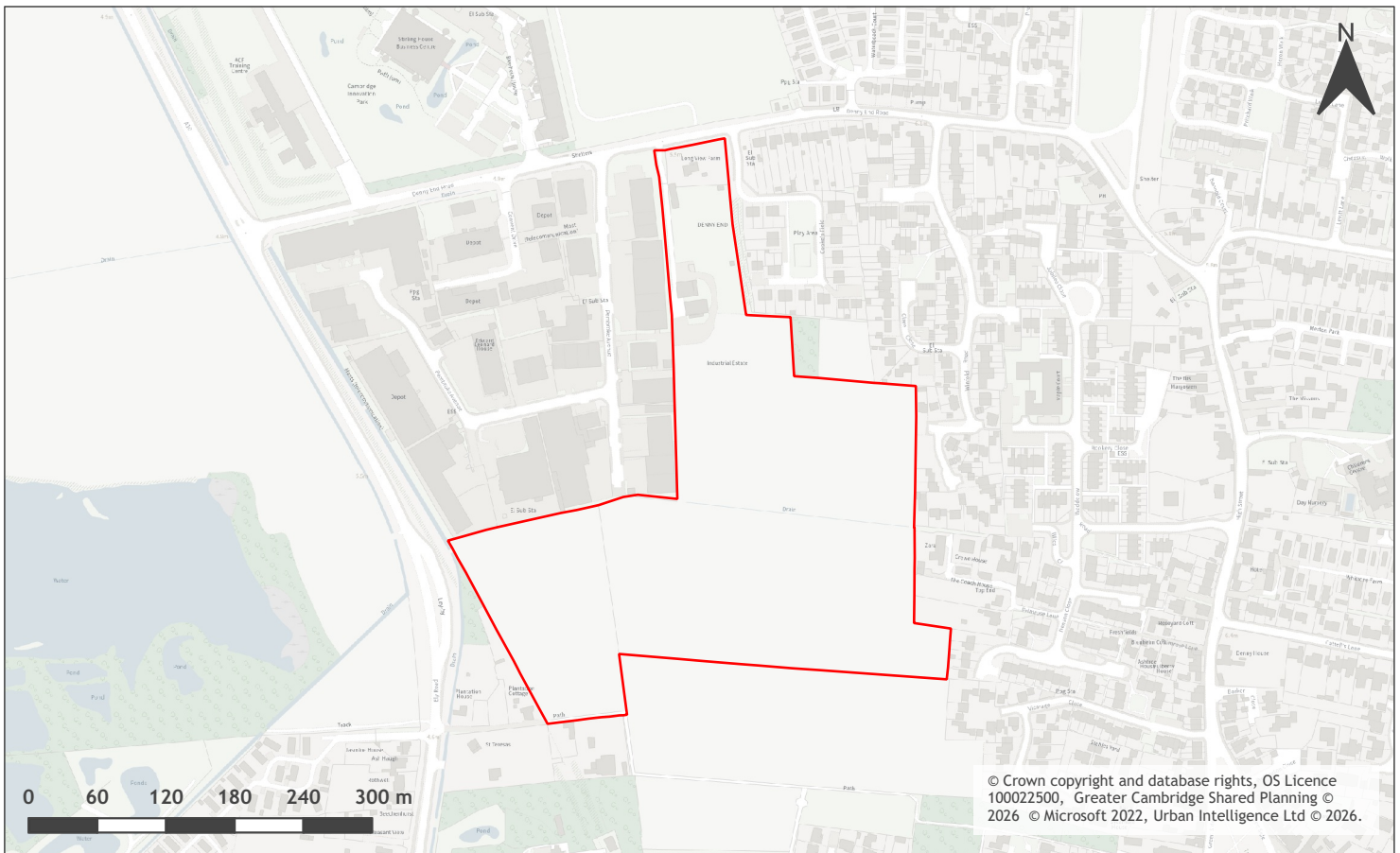


Land at Long View Farm, 75 Denny End Road, Waterbeach

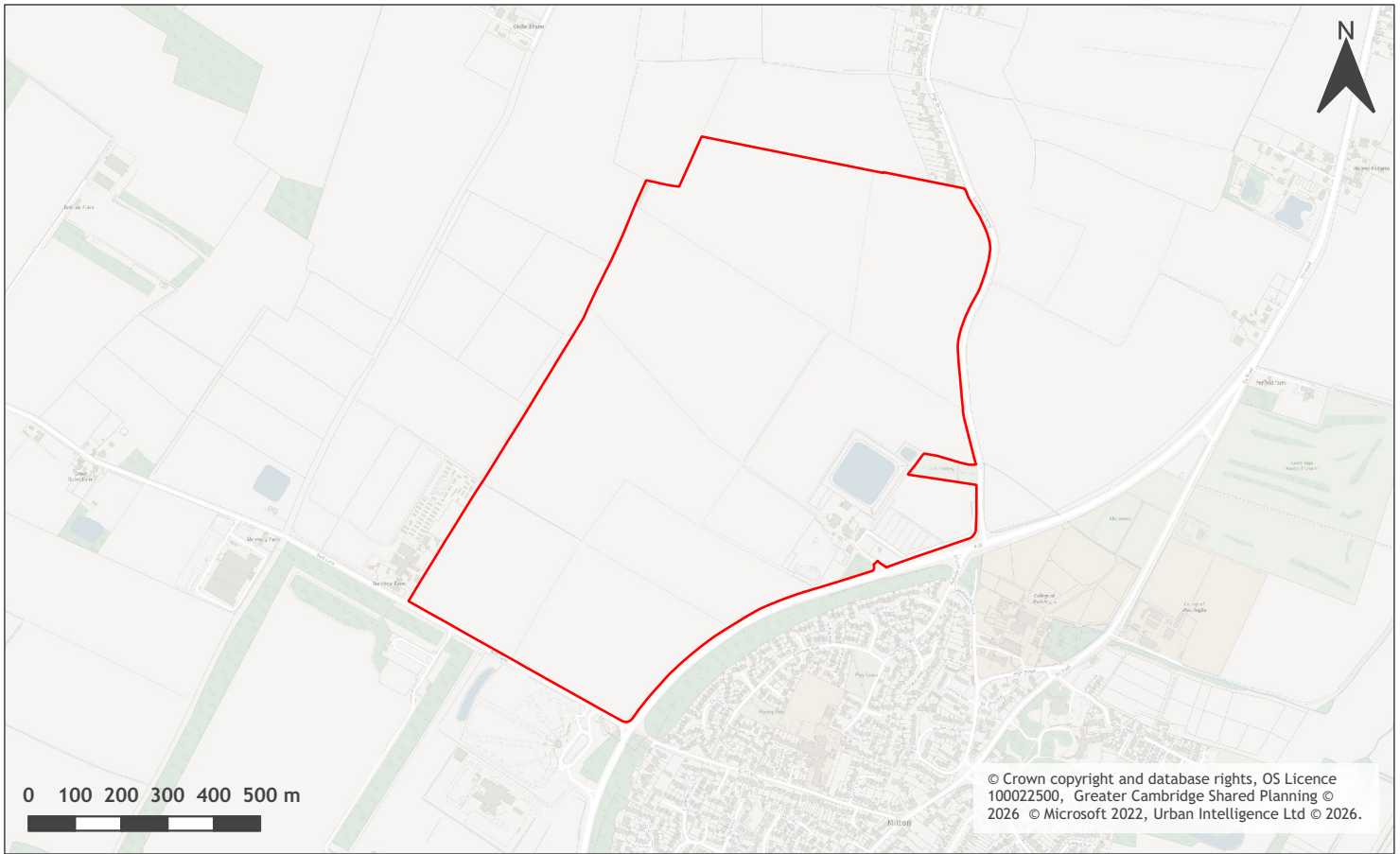

While the sensitivity assessment suggests that 'some' development of the site could be achieved with adequate mitigation, the site is also rated as a Moderate contributor to all three Greenbelt purposes and assessed as Very High when development is considered against Harm to the greenbelt. Due to the very large scale of the development site, and the harm it would cause to both greenbelt and landscape character, there is no change to the landscape rating.

Landscape Comment 2025	New information has been submitted in relation to the proposed new busway, which roughly dissects the site north to south. The presence of the busway does not alter previous landscape concerns greatly and arguably further degrades the rural character of the site. Previous findings continue to apply and the development of the site is likely to cause harm to the openness of the landscape character and the purposes of the Green Belt.

Landscape Comment 2023	Additional comments question the previous assessment scoring. In landscape terms, any development of the site would cause harm to the local openness, character and views in this area, which would be unalterable and not possible to mitigate against. Therefore there is no change to the original assessment score.

Landscape Comment 2021	A large site located to the north west of the village of Milton. Wide and local views are high due to lack of intervening vegetation and built form. Development upon this site would have a significant adverse impact to the local landscape character. It would be an encroachment into the landscape, isolated, an urbanisation of the rural landscape and permanent. Even with a reduction in residential units with landscape mitigation measures the harm would still be adverse, unacceptable and incongruous with the rural landscape.

The development would need to provide mitigation to reduce the vehicle impact and encourage active travel and public transport use. The development will need to be served by a bus stop and connect to the proposed Waterbeach to Cambridge Busway.
